Purpose: The purpose of this custom 1-day class is to improve the female officer's control tactics in order to improve her performance in a physical confrontation. Participants will review case studies, situational awareness, explore body platform positioning, balance and movement, whole-body explosive and CQB striking techniques, weapon management from the ground up, pat downs and hand cuffing, integrating weapon techniques, multiple officer engagement and tactics.

Requirements: Attendees are required to wear functional clothing, gun belts based on assignment, red/blue guns and TASER (if available) elbow, knee pads and mouthguards are recommended ***A water source and simple carbohydrate is also highly recommended.
